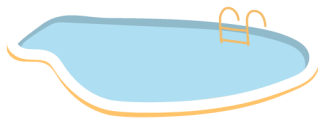
KIDMIN MOMENT

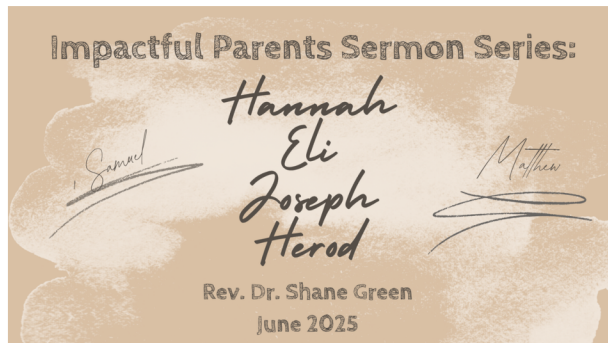
