Today we begin a new sermon series inspired by John Wesley's timeless image of salvation as a house. Wesley described repentance as the porch, faith as the door, and holiness of life as the very house itself. In this series, we will journey room by room into God's dwelling, discovering what it means to be welcomed, formed, and sent as disciples of Jesus Christ.

Each week we will step deeper into the house—standing on the porch of belief, entering through the door of faith, walking through the hallway of gifts, gathering at the table of grace, sitting in the study of Scripture, opening the living room of love, and finally moving into the kitchen, the warmest place of all, where fellowship and mission meet. This journey will help us see that discipleship is not just a decision we make, but a life we live.

As we explore these essential practices, we will learn that to believe is to belong, and to belong is to believe. God does not call us to admire the house from the outside, but to come in, dwell in His presence, and be shaped by His Spirit. In this way, discipleship becomes both inward—growing in holiness of heart—and outward—living in holiness of life as we love our neighbors and invite them to share in God's home.

Join us each week. Together, we will learn what it means not just to believe, but to belong—not just to visit occasionally, but to live daily—in the home Christ has prepared for us.





